Kenneth Youngblood advised the Duncan/Marlow Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #1192 will be closed in the near future. A special meeting of post members to consider distribution of post assets will be held November 4, 2025.

The Veterans' Day Parade will be held in Duncan Ok on Saturday, November 8, 2025. Parade will begin at Court House at 10:30 hours and will pause at the corner of Main and Ninth Streets where SCHG will participate in a ceremony honoring POW's and MIA's.

Dan Mitchell advises that the rental fee for the SCHG post office box will increase to \$122.00 during the coming year. \$122.00/month appears to be the new going rate for postal box rental.

Paul Frable announced that the Holy City of the Wichita's will hold a ceremony commemorating the establishment of the United States Marine Corps on Saturday November 15, 2025.
