Meeting called to order by Commander McAdory at 19:00 hours in the American Legion Building Comanche, OK. Roy Grabman offered the Invocation. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America recited by all present.

Minutes of October 30, 2025, business meeting were accepted as printed.

Financial Reports for November 2025 accepted as presented.

**Officer's Reports:**

Commander – Thanked membership for the cooperation and respect shown to other officers during his absence to personal and family medical issues. Contributions of newer members are really appreciated. As of the meeting date, ninety-two services were attended during the year. One more service is scheduled for November 22, 2025, with two additional services anticipated during the month of December. A joint Christmas Party with the Amvets and an awards ceremony are scheduled for December 13, 2025.

Honors rendered at funeral scheduled for November 22, 2025, at Duncan Cemetery will be a rendition of TAPS followed by the folding and presentation of the flag with no firing party.

Armorer – Nothing new to report

Secretary – Letter of thanks for the \$1,000.00 and appreciation received from the Ardmore OK Veterans Center was read to the assembled members.

Treasurer – Nothing additional to reports.

**Old Business:**

Amvets Post 11 requested a \$100.00 donation to cover part of the cost of meat for the joint Amvets/SCHG Christmas party on December 6, 2025. Commander McAvoy authorized the expenditure. Members who desire, may also participate in a voluntary dirty Santa gift exchange during the party.

**New Business:**

Cody Stringer proposed changes to the SCHG Membership Application Form. Two proposed forms were presented for consideration. One is a standard 8 ½” by 11” sheet that includes applicant’s data and a

uniform order form. The other is an 8 ½" X 11" tri-fold form with personal data, a uniform order form as well as the SCHG Mission Statement, a brief description of services provided by the organization and the time and location of regular business meetings. Dan Mitchell tendered a motion that SCHG print one hundred copies of the tri-fold on glossy card stock and two hundred on standard stationery. Motion also includes a provision that SCHG reimburse Cody Stringer for the cost of card stock, stationery, and ink. John Saville seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Treasurer Mitchell advised that the SCHG Certificate of Deposit will mature in April 2026. Commander McAdory instructed the Treasurer that upon expiration monies currently in the Certificate of Deposit be transferred to a Money Market account in order to benefit from a higher interest rate and improved liquidity offered by most Money Market instruments.
